A key part of her presentation was the notion that the CLGs should find a way to become more integrated with the Main Street Programs. The Main Street conference will be held at Frankfort next year (January) and can count as annual training for HDC members who attend. She will be sending out information on the conference soon, which Fred will pass along to HDC members and others who might want to attend. There were some questions and discussions throughout the presentation.

Glen Payne, from CRE Planning, presented an update on the historic district survey and inventory effort. The project is at its mid-point and it appears to be going smooth. Mr. Payne anticipates that the project will conclude in about 60 days. He demonstrated his work to the HDC by showing how the Ruskinarc survey tool works and he explained what we can expect once the project is completed.
